Possible hazards

A highly flammable liquid the fumes of which may self-ignite and explode. While burning or being heated it releases toxic vapours. It irritates eyes, mucous membranes and respiratory organs.

Instruction to follow in case of a road accident

- Park the vehicle in a lay-by free area and switch off the engine
- Eliminate all sources of a possible ignition
- Do not use naked fire. Do not smoke.
- Sign the carriageway as dangerous and warn other drivers.
- Prevent the public from entering the hazardous area.
- If you can't avoid handling the barrels - Do not slide them! Apply rolling them with the maximum possible caution (rolling may produce scintillation).

Means of protection

Wear protection glasses, protection clothing and gloves. A suitable respirator or gas-mask equipped with a filter giving protection against organic fumes will be sufficient.

First aid protection

Inhalation: Carry the affected individual out of the contaminated space. If the person cannot breathe by oneself, introduce the mouth-to-mouth respiration and call in medical help.

Skin : Take off the contaminated wear and rinse the bodily parts affected.

Eyes : Immediately rinse with a large quantity of clean water and see the doctor.

If taken: Immediately rinse the mouth with water. Have the effected person drink 2-4 cups of water and attempt to provoke vomiting. See the doctor.

Instruction to follow in case of a fire excluding the load

- Fight the fire using all possible means to prevent the load's ignition!
- If possible, move the vehicle to an open space, so that the public is not exposed to danger.
- Detach the vehicle from the articulated trailer.
- Warn the public. Evacuate the hazardous area.

Instruction to follow in case of a fire including the load

- Apply extinguishing media such as water spray, alcohol-resistant foam, carbon dioxide, dry powders.
- There is a danger of explosion and release of toxic gases.
- Warn the public to evacuate the hazardous area.
- If possible, try to fight the fire from a protected location.
- Intact packagings to be cooled with water.
- Keep on the windward side of the fire.
- Prevent the extinguishing water from entering the drainage.

Measures to be taken in case of an accidental leak

Do not use tools that might cause scintillation - high risk of explosion!!

- Wear the basic means of personal protection for eyes, skin and respiratory organs.
- Avoid contamination of both the surface and underground water and soil.
- Large quantities of the leaked liquid to be pumped out. Smaller quantities or the remains of the liquid to be treated with a loose, blotting material (such as diatomaceous earth or sand), deposited in a waste vessel and rendered harmless.
- By all means prevent the leaked substance from entering the drainage.
